Preferred Drug List (PDL) Changes Effective September 1, 2014

On June 26, 2014, the Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee of the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services' Division of Health Care Financing and Policy met to review new and existing therapeutic drug classes on the Nevada Medicaid Preferred Drug List (PDL).

The actions taken by the committee are indicated below. All changes are effective September 1, 2014. The complete PDL is posted on the "<u>Preferred Drug List</u>" webpage.
