Attention Provider Types 30 and 83: Service Plans Will No Longer Be Faxed to Providers

Effective May 1, 2016, Hewlett Packard Enterprise will no longer fax the Nevada Medicaid Functional Assessment Service Plan (FASP) to provider types 30 and 83. Instead, the FASP will be sent via secure email to the provider. Providers are therefore advised to check their Nevada Medicaid/Nevada Check Up enrollment to verify their email address for receipt of the FASP. Providers are also advised to ensure that they are registered to utilize the Provider Web Portal. To complete provider changes online, please login to the secure Provider Web Portal, and choose "Revalidate-Update Provider" or use the Provider Information Change Form (FA-33).
