

Claim Forms: New Versions of CMS-1500 and ADA Are Now Valid

The new CMS-1500 (08/05) and 2006 ADA claim forms can now be used to submit Nevada Medicaid/Nevada Check Up claims.

Providers who submit the CMS-1500 may use either the new version (08/05) or the current version (12/90) now through April 1, 2007. The new version (08/05) will be required for all CMS-1500 claims received at First Health Services on or after April 2, 2007. Dental providers may use either the new 2006 ADA form or the current form(s) (ADA 1999 version 2000 or



ADA 2002, 2004) now through May 22. The 2006 ADA will be required on all claims received at First Health Services on or after May 23, 2007.

NPI Reminders: Please send your NPI to First Health Services as soon as possible by completing and returning the questionnaires being mailed to all providers or the <u>Provider Information Change Form (FH-33)</u> posted at https://medicaid.nv.gov. Providers who are not required or eligible to obtain an NPI will be issued an Atypical Provider Identifier (API) by First Health Services in January 2007. **You must continue to enter your current nine-digit Provider Medicaid Number in the appropriate fields on all claims with date of receipt at First Health Services on or before May 22, 2007.** In addition, you may begin entering your NPI/API in the appropriate fields of the new CMS-1500 (08/05) and 2006 ADA claim forms now and on the new UB-04 when that form goes into effect on March 1, 2007.
