Submitting Medicare Crossover Claims

You now have **two** options for submitting Medicare crossover claims to First Health Services.

You may submit a CMS-1500 or UB-92 claim form with a copy of your Medicare EOB, <u>or</u> you may submit the Medicare Crossover Claim Form (FH-40). If you submit form FH-40, there is no need to include a copy of your Medicare EOB.

Attach EOBs to All Claims

If a recipient has a primary insurance carrier in addition to Nevada Medicaid benefits, First Health Services now requires that you attach a copy of the other carrier's Explanation of Benefits (EOB) to your claim regardless of whether the other insurance carrier paid or denied your claim.

The one exception to this rule is submitting a crossover claim using the Medicare Crossover Claim Form. In this case, (as stated above) an EOB is not required.
