## Notification Regarding Denial of Claims with ICD-10 Glaucoma Codes as the Primary Diagnosis Code

Claims with ICD-10 glaucoma codes as the primary diagnosis code have been denying incorrectly. The Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) will be updated to correctly process claims which are submitted on or after September 11, 2017. Affected claims that denied incorrectly will be automatically reprocessed; providers do not need to resubmit or appeal the denied claims. A future web announcement will notify providers when the claims will be reprocessed.

The following ICD-10 glaucoma codes are impacted by this issue and are allowed to be billed as the primary diagnosis code:
