Public Workshop Scheduled Regarding Federal Regulation Requiring the Use of an Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) System for Personal Care Services

The Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) System requirement was passed by Congress as part of H.R.34 - 21st Century Cures Act, and signed into law on December 13, 2016. The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) will present a Public Workshop to discuss the EVV federal requirement, as well as the requirement that each Personal Care Attendant obtain a National Provider Identifier (NPI) and enroll with Medicaid as a servicing provider under the provider type(s) (PTs) for which they provide services. All Personal Care Services (PCS) providers are encouraged to attend.
