Attention Electronic Billing Trading Partners and Providers:

Preparations for the Medicaid Management Information System Modernization Project

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) will implement a new, modernized Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) in February 2019. The changes will improve the electronic claims submission and claims search functionalities that Trading Partners and providers use.

Trading Partners are service centers or clearinghouses that submit Medicaid claims electronically on behalf of Nevada Medicaid and Nevada Check Up providers; providers that submit claims directly to Nevada Medicaid are also Trading Partners. Beginning in August, Trading Partners will need to complete the following items to prepare for the transition to the new system and to be able to submit claims/encounters through the new system:

- All current and new Trading Partners will need to enroll on the Nevada Medicaid Provider Web Portal as a Trading Partner in order to obtain a new Trading Partner ID.
- All Trading Partners will be required to test transactions in the new system before submitting claims/encounters through the new system.
- Trading partners will need to make changes to their interface files per instructions in the EDI companion guides. New companion guides for Fee-for-Service and Encounter claims are scheduled to be posted to the Nevada Medicaid website at <https://www.medicaid.nv.gov/providers/edi.aspx> in May 2018. Future emails will notify Trading Partners when these guides are available online, as well as when other companion guides become available.

Please note: Providers who use a Trading Partner will want to make sure your Trading Partner is aware of these upcoming changes.

More information will be communicated to providers and Trading Partners in the coming months. In preparation for the MMIS modernization project, please make sure your Trading Partner contact information with Nevada Medicaid is up to date.
