Modernization: Provider Training Scheduled for January 2019; Modernization Project Webpage Created

Provider training on the modernized Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) will occur in January 2019. The four-hour training will include details about the new system, policy and enforcement changes. It is imperative that providers receive training to prevent any delays in processing transactions such as enrollment/revalidation, claims and prior authorizations.

Access to register for training will start November 1, 2018, through the new Modernization Project webpage on the Nevada Medicaid website at www.medicaid.nv.gov. To open the new webpage, click on the "Modernization Project" link under "Featured Links" on the left-hand side of each page of the website. This page will include information about modernization in areas such as training registration, training materials, web announcements and known issues. This page launched on September 17, 2018. Refer to it often to stay aware of upcoming changes and details that impact the provider community.
