Age Restriction Removed for Certain Childhood Diagnosis Codes and All Perinatal Diagnosis Codes

Effective with claims processed on or after June 15, 2020, the age restriction has been removed from ICD-10 diagnosis codes R62.50 (Unspecified lack of expected normal physiological development in childhood), R62.52 (Short stature (child)) and R62.59 (Other lack of expected normal physiological development in childhood) and perinatal ICD-10 codes P00-P96.9.

For guidelines for billing certain conditions originating in the perinatal period, see <u>Web Announcement 2178</u>.

The following claims that processed on or after February 1, 2019, and before June 15, 2020, will be automatically reprocessed. A future remittance advice message will notify providers when the claims are reprocessed.

- Claims with diagnosis codes R62.50, R62.52, and R62.59 that denied with error codes 4145, 4146, 4147, 4148, 4152, 4154, 4155, 4156, 4157, 4158, 4159, 4160, 4161, 4162, 4165, 4166, 4167, 4168, 4173, 4177, 4179, 4187, 4188, 4189, 4190, and 4191.
- Claims with diagnosis codes P00-P96.9 that denied with error code 4193.

Please note: When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing.
