## **OptumRx Pharmacy Benefits Manager System Updates**

Effective March 22, 2021, OptumRx, the Pharmacy Benefits Manager for Nevada Medicaid, will be directly utilizing the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) rebate indicator to process Nevada Medicaid claims. Due to the update, providers may notice that some over-the-counter (OTC) and/or prescription drugs that had previously paid may now reject with a non-rebate message and are no longer payable for pharmacy and physician-administered drug claims. The following reject message will display for non-rebate products: "PRODUCT DOES NOT OFFER FEDERAL REBATE, SELECT DIFFERENT PRODUCT OR NDC"

When a non-rebate reject message is received, the pharmacy or prescriber will need to utilize an alternative product.
