The Nevada Silver State Scripts Board (SSSB) met on July 29, 2021, and voted to adopt the following changes effective November 1, 2021.

Drug Class/Program	Changes
Analgesics – Opiate Agonists	Hydrocodone bitartrate added as non-preferred.
Analgesics – Opiate Agonists - Abuse Deterrent	Embeda®, MorphaBond® and Arymo® ER removed from PDL. Hydrocodone bitartrate added as non-preferred.
Cardiovascular Agents – Antilipemics – PCSK9 Inhibitors (NEW)	Praluent® and Repatha® added as preferred.
Dermatological Agents – Topical Anti-Infectives – Topical Scabicides	Ivermectin topical added as non-preferred.
Gastrointestinal Agents – Functional Gastrointestinal Disorder Drugs	Lubiprostone added as non-preferred.
Neurological Agents – Anti-Migraine Agents – CGRP Receptor Antagonists	Vyepti® added as non-preferred.
Ophthalmic Agents – Antiglaucoma Agents	Brimonidine moved to non-preferred and Brinzolamide added as non-preferred.
Psychotropic Agents – Antipsychotics – Atypical Antipsychotics – Oral/Topical	Asenapine added as non-preferred. Invega® added as preferred.
