Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs) Health Care Provider Assessment/Survey

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is partnering with the Nevada Primary Care Office (PCO) to complete the health professional shortage areas (HPSAs) Health Care Provider Assessment/Survey. These designations leverage federal resources that help states improve access to primary care, dental care and mental health care, including loan repayment and scholarships for health care professionals throughout Nevada.

During January 2022, the DHCFP, along with community organization volunteers, will be calling provider offices to ask the questions needed to complete the survey. Please let your front office, human resources, office managers and billing staff know they may be receiving these telephone calls. Alternatively, you or your staff may complete the survey online. Surveys must be completed by January 31, 2022.
