## Attention Provider Types 64 (Hospice) and 65 (Hospice, Long Term Care):

## **Update Regarding Error Code for Outpatient and Inpatient Hospice Claims Submitted With Same Date of Service**

Outpatient hospice claims and inpatient hospice claims may not be submitted with the same date of service. Effective on claims with dates of service on or after January 30, 2023, when an outpatient claim submitted by provider type (PT) 64 (Hospice) and an inpatient claim submitted by PT 65 (Hospice, Long Term Care) have the same date of service, the second claim received will deny with error code 5029 (Possible conflict outpatient hospice vs inpatient hospice).

Error code 5029 has been created to match policy for hospice claims. Outpatient and inpatient hospice claims with the same date of service will deny on a go-forward basis. No claims will be reprocessed.

Please disregard the above information. The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) has decided to reverse the changes made under error code 5029 (Possible conflict outpatient hospice vs inpatient hospice) to allow outpatient provider type 64 (Hospice) and inpatient provider type 65 (Hospice, Long Term Care) claims with the same date of service. Claims with dates of service on or after January 30, 2023, that have denied inappropriately with error code 5029 will be reprocessed automatically at a later date. A future web announcement will notify providers when the claims are reprocessed.
