COVID-19 UNWIND: COVID-19 Billing Guide Updated

Nevada Medicaid has updated the COVID-19 General Billing Guide with the following information:

- The COVID-19 public health emergency will end on May 11, 2023. Nevada Medicaid will continue to provide coverage of COVID-19 testing, including over-the-counter tests, vaccine administration, standalone counseling for children, and treatment.
- Certain COVID-19 flexibilities and blanket waivers will end on May 11, 2023. Please see [Web Announcement 3049](#).
- Prior authorization flexibilities will end on May 11, 2023.
- Coverage of COVID-19 Temporary (uninsured population) will end on May 11, 2023.
- The following procedure code has been added for COVID-19 vaccines:
 - 0174A administration code (Booster), Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent, age 6 months to 4 years old, effective 3/14/2023.

For any Current Procedural Terminology (CPT)/Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes that are listed above but have not yet been implemented in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS), claims will be suspended and then reprocessed once implemented.
