## **Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3127**

### **COVID-19 UNWIND: COVID-19 General Billing Guide Updated**

Nevada Medicaid has updated the COVID-19 General Billing Guide with the following information:

- Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes for COVID-19 vaccine standalone counseling have been corrected due to a typo. Utilize G0314 or G0315 (not G3014 and G3015) for COVID-19 vaccine standalone counseling for children under the age of 21 years old.
  - Encounter-based providers must bill using their encounter code and the standalone vaccine counseling code with modifier Q2. The claim will pay according to the established encounter rate and the standalone vaccine counseling code will pay at \$0 as the service is included in the encounter reimbursement. This will allow the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) to track this service for federal reporting purposes.
- Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) end dates for monovalent COVID-19 vaccines have been corrected due to a typo. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration revoked EUA coverage for COVID-19 vaccines starting April 18, 2023. Therefore, Nevada Medicaid will deny any monovalent COVID-19 vaccines administered on April 18, 2023, and forward.
