The bivalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are excluded from coverage

The FDA announced on September 11, 2023 that the bivalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized for use in the United States. Nevada Medicaid has excluded these products from pharmacy coverage.

The updated Moderna and Pfizer mRNA COVID-19 Vaccines (2023-2024 Formula) are covered and should be used for all doses administered to individuals 6 months of age and older per FDA eligibility guidelines.
