ICD-10 Testing and Facts Information

As Nevada Medicaid approaches the ICD-10 implementation on October 1, 2015, trading partners and providers are asking about testing with Nevada Medicaid. Trading partners and providers who are interested in testing ICD-10 claim transactions may contact HP Enterprise Services (HPES) at nvicd10testing@hp.com and HPES will send additional testing information. Testing will begin in late June/early July. Trading partners and providers are encouraged to test prior to the federal mandate date for ICD-10, which is October 1, 2015. It is critical that trading partners and providers test with Nevada Medicaid prior to the mandated date to ensure readiness for all parties and reduce the impact of this implementation for all parties.

Providers who use a clearinghouse to submit claims are encouraged to contact their clearinghouse to make sure they test with HPES prior to the mandated date for ICD-10.

ICD-10 Facts

- Federal mandate under Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) regulations
- National impact: mandatory for all HIPAA-covered entities such as hospitals, physicians, dental providers, long-term care providers, DME providers, small provider offices, laboratories, clearinghouses, hardware/software vendors and billing agencies
- Mandatory compliance date October 1, 2015
